



God Knows We Forget

• The butler forgot Joseph (Gen. 40:14,23 / 41:9)

Then the chief butler spoke to Pharaoh, saying: "I remember my faults this day.

 Israel forgot the Sabbath Day (Exo. 20:8 / Neh. 13:15-18)

Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, "What evil thing is this that you do, by which you profane the Sabbath day?
